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DFW/IAH/SAT Customs Clearance

Customs clearance at DFW/IAH/SAT Airports is relatively smooth in comparison to other ports and can be done ahead of the shipment to provide better efficiency and shorter wait time for pets upon arrival. Please provide copies of the following documents in one email at least 24 hours prior to arrival to help us get this done as timely as possible:

- ✓ Health Certificate
- ✓ Rabies Certificate done >30 days before arrival, but still valid with no more than a 3 year re-vaccination interval.
- ✓ Air Waybill with the owner as the consignee c/o AirVets Pet Relocation
- ✓ Owner's passport or US State Driver's License/ID
- ✓ Attached Customs Clearance Authorization form signed by owner

Screwworm Certification

In order to import animals into the United States from countries where screwworm is present, a certification statement is needed to show that the animal(s) in the shipment have been examined within 5 days and are free of screwworm.
